

Digital Images

All images need to be downloaded to your flickr account by midnight BEFORE the due date, so they can be viewed by the class **ON THEIR DUE DATES!**

Remember: Due date is **VIEW** date! :)

You must provide your **own** digital picture-taking device. Cell phones, i-pads, and other mobile devices with apps are acceptable, as are digital cameras.

The **number** of digital images will vary per assignment. See board or teacher website for this week's details, including subject/topic and points possible. Scroll down for a **rubric** with 50 points possible. **Late** work receives 2 points off for each day it is late unless arrangements have been made with the instructor. Deadlines are extended one day for each day of excused absence, and will not receive any penalty point deduction provided the images are downloaded by class time.

You may **edit** images in any software or apps of your choosing, or simply download straight captures without any edits. You need to provide your own cables and instructions for downloading. Images stored in your i-photo accounts can easily be transferred to your flickr home page by clicking the flickr icon at the bottom right corner of the image or group of images highlighted.

- Please arrange all images in a **SET**, with the correct assignment title/subject which will be on the board and web-site.
- Flickr resets their clock at 12:01AM the first day of the month, so please **plan** your uploading accordingly. Even if you delete images you do not want, your space used does not decrease. Approximately 45-60 images a month may be downloaded, but the space used by each depends on your camera.
- You do **not** need to PAY for a professional account.
- With the free accounts, flickr will begin to archive your images at number 201. You will not have any more than that to turn in this semester, but make sure you **do not download** images you do not intend to turn in, because you may have some of your older images automatically archived. You can see archives only if you purchase a pro account (\$25 per year) or if you delete other images.

If you are having **difficulties** with your computer or camera, please see the instructor before the view date. You may write a note and hand it to the teacher, or speak to the teacher about problems any time prior to the beginning of class on the due date.
